

## INSTRUCTIONS

Anders Ruff Printables

### USEFUL TOOLS

- Sewing machine
  - Scrap fabric
  - Scrap ribbon
  - Pillow stuffing
- Scissors, needle & thread

### SUGGESTED MATERIALS

- 8.5x11 Bright White Cardstock

### STUFFED EASTER BUNNY

- Print template on 8.5x11 cardstock.
- Trim along line.
- Cut two pieces of fabric, allowing 1/4" extra all the way around template. Fabric will be approximately 7" x 11.5".
- Trace bunny on reverse side of fabric, 1/4" outside of the template line (draw it freehand, so the bunny is bigger than template).
- Pin both pieces of fabric together, (right side to right side) and cut both at once with pinking scissors.
- Flip fabric and place together (wrong side to wrong side), so right sides are exposed. Repin together.
- Starting at the bottom left foot, sew 1/4" along the entire edge until you reach the right foot. Leave 2" opening at the bottom for stuffing.
- Stuff bunny.
- Hand stitch bottom to close.
- Tie ribbon around neck.
- Sew on a 2.5" - 3" yarn pom for bunny tail. Tails will create a way for bunnies to stand upright.
